In your email dated October 19, 2021, you advised that the Niagara Peninsula Conservation Authority is requesting that our Niagara 2022 Canada Games Host Society provide a memo committing to address Section 6.2.6 of the NPCA Policy Document. That section applies to recreational uses within a valleyland setting and calls for the submission of a revegetation plan to ensure that there is no net loss of natural vegetation.

This memo provides that commitment on behalf of our Host Society in relation to the Twelve Mile Creek trail work. Our Host Society will ensure that there is no net loss of natural revegetation through a number of measures that may include:

1. Minimizing the loss of natural vegetation through measures such as undertaking work on trails that already exist;
2. Where appropriate, revegetating areas of disturbed soil with a native seed mix immediately upon completion of work;
3. Where appropriate, identify and apply native plantings/seed mix around trail features; and
4. Monitoring on a regular basis to ensure that revegetation has established successfully, and to undertake such re-seeding during the growing season as appropriate to ensure vegetative cover of disturbed areas.

In addition, the Host Society commits to participate in a site visit with the NPCA upon completion of the work to ensure that this commitment has been achieved.
